



## Quiet Time (Day 2) Making Change: Vision

**Scripture:** John 14:12; Ephesians 3:20

### **Summary & Lesson:**

Not only do we need to be radical about dealing with sin, but we also need to be radical in taking our relationship with God to a place we could never imagine possible. At times when we struggle and see no real changes made in ourselves we can blame God saying, "He doesn't really want me to grow anyway." The real issue isn't with God; it's with our faith and vision for what God can really do with us. You are his chosen instrument, his people. To the disciple who has great faith in the Lord, nothing limits him.

Looking in the Old Testament we see many examples of men and women who did not believe that God could use them for the task He set out for them; and yet, because they were obedient to God, they put His plan into action. Sometimes the first step to believing is doing. It's easy to be hurt and faithless in ourselves (we have all been there), but when we show God we are willing to try it His way—you'll believe! Jesus even tells us in John 14:12b that, "He will do even greater things than these." There is so much that God can use you for if you simply believe that he will. You could baptize your fellow employees, classmates, neighbors, overcome a sin that you thought you would never defeat; there is no end to the possibilities with God!!!!

### **Personal Applications:**

2. Do you believe that God can do great things through you?
3. Make a list of any barriers in your path, and decide that they won't get in the way.

### **Take it to God:**

1. Ask God to give you a greater vision that you have ever had to become more than you ever thought possible.
